Subject: **ADVANCED COMMUNICATION TRAINING - APRIL 29, 2018**

SUMMARY

The Conference's Communication Department is running a training for all local churches' **audio technical persons** and **relevant media leaders** in April, 2018.

1. Training: **Advanced Communication Training Skills**
2. Date: **Sunday April 29, 10am – 12pm**
3. Venue: **Carr Memorial Primary School, NCD**
4. Level: **Intermediate to Expert**

BACKGROUND

1. The Papua New Guinea Union Mission's (PNGUM) major Communication project this year is the **Hope Radio FM**, which aims to be launched in **November, 2018**
2. The PAU radio station 2G has been transferred to PNGUM in Lae which will be rebranded as **107.5 Hope Radio FM**
3. The technical aspects of the studio, transmission are being progressed by another sub-committee
4. As part of the preparation, CPC is joining other sister local missions to prepare content or programs that will be aired on Hope FM throughout the country
5. CPC is tasked to produce songs, sermons and specific programs particularly in the areas of **health (lifestyle), children, finance with testimonials** etc.
6. PNGUM has scheduled **July 2018** as the month in which CPC will be recording its content. However, local churches with capacity should commence immediately
7. CPC plans to purchase **multiple sets** of recording items to assist local churches and districts in bigger events such as camp meetings, trainings, evangelistic meetings etc. to maintain the **standard and quality of recording**

8. With these sets, a schedule will be drawn up in which possible local district events and local church activities will be recorded
9. Hence, a training to highlight the **standards of the procedures, skills and equipment** needed to produce **studio grade content** will be run at the above mentioned time and venue to fulfil this requirement
10. Participants from local churches are advised to bring your **local church and district planners (with possible dates)** to this training so as to assist facilitators and Director on next steps to assist your local church or district.

TARGET AUDIENCE

1. Only those audio technicians (techies) who have had experience in media, recording, sound engineering with **intermediate to expert level proficiency** are invited to attend
2. The training will assume an advanced level of competency and is **not intended for beginners.**

TRAINING EXPECTATIONS

1. The practical hands-on sessions will involve standards training in **procedure and equipment** needed for recording content in your local church
2. Demo will be using **Adobe Creative Suite (CS6)**
3. Participants are encouraged, where possible, to use personal laptops with working versions of Adobe CS6 for maximum value in training.

District Directors and Church Pastors are urged to ensure every **local church board** appoints a representative who have the **necessary skills** and should **come prepared** in order to participate in this training.

May the good Lord continue to bless our efforts and commitment in the last remaining days of Earth's history.
