Within the 4 years Shine Service projects were carried out according to the objectives and outcomes of what was stipulated in the 5 Year action plan for the Children Ministries. In the four years from 2014 to 2017 the areas of Shine Service projects were conducted in;

- 1. 2014 Home environment
- 2. 2015 Local church & Community
- 3. 2016 Remote Districts of CPC
- 4. 2017 urban District National Capital District
- 5. 2018 CPC Wide All Districts

Many lives have been touched through the various Shine Service projects including non-Adventist villages. The spin off blessings from such activities is huge therefore we want to praise God for impressing on our minds the best possible activities we can focus on through the years. May we continue to shine for Jesus through the shine activities.

TASK: Ministering to the Pastors, Ministers, Volunteers and Bible workers of both the Seventh-day Adventist Church and the other Christian clergy in Central Papua Conference.

How to plan and organize for the Shine Service Program.

- 1. Form a committee which compromises of the Ministries in the church that deals with the needs of the children. Children Ministry, Family Life, Women Ministry, Education Secretaries, Pathfinder and Adventurer, Children's Elder and the Sabbath School Council Members.
- 2. Invite them for a meeting and discuss the nature of this Service Project for the 9th of September 2018.
- 3. There are two parts to this Shine Service Project. Part A is to minister through acts of service to the Adventist Missionaries AND Part B is to minister to the non-Adventist Clergy. As a leader you will divide the children and the church family to two groups. One group for Part A and the second group for Part B.
- 4. On Sunday the **9**th **of September Group A of** your local church will give a surprise visit to the Pastors homes with anything important that the lord will impress each leader to organize for the Children and the church to give to their Pastors.
- 5. Do a short program for the day's activities and involve Children to participate in the program.
- 6. PART B. Part B involves ministering to the non-Adventist Clergy. Do a little survey in your church vicinity and find out about the non-Adventist churches that are close by your Church. Group B will visit the homes of the non-Adventist clergy. Before this visit let them know that you will be visiting on the 9th September. One of the gifts to resource the non-Adventist clergy with is the Seventh-day Adventist Ministers Bible. The Bible cost K150.00 from the Adventist Book Shop and the Women's Study Bible cost K220.00. These Bibles will be given to the non-Adventist clergy and his spouse during this visit.
- **7.** Divide the children and families in your local church into group A and group B and reach out to the two groups on the 9th of September 2018.
- 8. Divide the total cost of the Bibles by the number of children in your local church and advise how much each child and family will donate to purchase these Bibles.

Example: The total cost of the Bibles are K150.00 and K220.00. If you have a total of 60 children in your local church, divide them into two groups. Group 1 will contribute K5.00 each for the Ministers Bible and Group 2 will contribute K7.40 for the Women's Study Bible.
