**SUBJECT: CPC CHILDREN MINISTRY PNGUM SONOMA LEADERSHIP CONVENTION UPDATES**

The Children Ministry wishes to inform the CPC Delegates who are attending the PNGUM Leadership Convention in Sonoma from the **6<sup>th</sup> to the 10<sup>th</sup> of December 2019** with important information for the remaining month of November before the travel date on **the 4<sup>th</sup> of December**.

### **1. Number of delegates with paid Air Niugini tickets**

Ninety-five [95] CPC delegates have paid for their tickets for the travel to Rabaul on the **4<sup>th</sup> of December**. This includes **7** who have booked and paid out of the special fare arrangements. **79** registered delegates are yet to confirm their tickets for the travel. There are only **six [6]** available spaces for the **K1289.00 fare**. Ticket payments for the special fare will not be entertained after the six [6] spaces are filled. Those who are late to pay the special fare will now pay a much higher fare of **K1615.00**. This is an increase of **K174.00**. We encouraged those who are still to pay to find a much cheaper fare with PNG Air so that you can still make it for the Program.

### **3. K50.00 Contribution budget details**

Each delegate has been asked to contribute K50.00 to support the travel expenses that will occur out of the convention expenses.

Firstly, Sonoma College has charges for the Dormitories before and after the convention. These information was not relayed on time before the tickets were purchased therefore Sunny Bird SDA Church is willing to provide accommodation for the two days before and after the convention.

Those delegates who wished to book into Hotels or Lodges in Kokopo are free to make their arrangements however Sunny Bird SDA Church is the place to be for the two days before the convention.

#### **Here is the Budget breakup of the K50.00**

- 1. K10.00 – Entry fee to the Volcano Hot Spring at Matupit Island on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2019.**
- 2. K20.00 – Transport fees – Tokua to Sunny Bird & Sunny Bird to Sonoma**
- 3. K20.00 – Lunch Pack – Traditional menu with kulau drinks – This will be eaten in the course of the Tour & sightseeing on Wednesday.**
- 4. The food items each delegate is asked to pack will support the delegates for the two days before and after camp.**
- 5. Accommodation at Sonoma College for the Convention**

Accommodation at the college will be a great challenge during the convention because the dormitory spaces are not enough to cater for all participants. The rooms can only cater for 4 occupants because of the beds however the rooms are big enough to accommodate 6 occupants.

The room groupings have been done according to churches to make it easy for each participant to be comfortable with their church friends.

If you want to have a private space of your own, you can bring your tent and pitch close to the Dormitories so that you are able to use the ablution block for your comfort. Those who are going together as spouses can opt for a tent.

### 6. Shine Service Project

There will be a Shine Service Project done at the college to teach Local Missions who haven't been involving in the Shine Service Project. A shirt has been organized by the Children Ministry in the Conference for those who are interested to wear during the convention on Monday and Tuesdays respectively for the Shine presentation. CPC has been participating in the Shine Service Project for the last 5 years therefore if we wear this shirt together we would impact the Local Missions to be mission focus and give generously for God's work and for the Kingdom.

Those wishing to have a T Shirt or collar shirt can bring their preferred **YELLOW** shirts for printing at a cost of **K15.00 print** at the office. All payments must be done at the Children Ministry office and receipted for your payment records.
